LETTER TO PETE DELEA AT DNR

In the case of Donna Hockman v. Commonwealth of Virginia

Your attention is greatly needed to address and in the vindication of the following matters involved in the prosecution of this criminal case.

It appearing that the media gave inflammatory and prejudicial reports regarding the prosecution of my case, it would satisfy the interest of society to see that justice and the truth is brought forth to all. The job of a journalist is to expose the truth, regardless of the consequences to the parties for which the truth would reveal. The truth is all I am concerned with, and in my case, is that the truth would vindicate me.

Before you toss this letter in the trash please read on.

Ask yourself this question; if, you were convicted of 1st degree murder and your prosecutor continued to block your avenues of receiving documents and investigating the circumstances surrounding your conviction, wouldn't you believe she doesn't want you to know the truth? That's exactly what my prosecutor has done. She has even gone so far as to reach out to the former warden of this facility and had me removed from the Honor housing unit and dog program. The Wardens reason given is because she was made aware of a website created by my family displaying evidence proving that my conviction was obtained by the state illegally. There is no doubt I am being held unlawfully based on the laws set forth by the United States Constitution. This website has been taken down within the last few months due to the cost of maintaining it. The letter posted on this site that prompted my prosecutor to take the action of removing me from my housing status and dog program is as follows:

Posted Monday March 14th, 2011

"I wake each day knowing I was wrongfully convicted of murder. I've shed tears for the life I took and the pain and suffering my actions have inflicted on all those involved. This tragedy could have been prevented had authorities intervened when I finally reached out for help. You know my trial was not fair and you allowed perjury, altered, never tested and destroyed evidence to be used to win my conviction. My testimony was the truth. My motive was not jealousy, but survival. You knew the facts before I went to trial but you chose to disregard them for personal and political gain. So many things took place in the weeks and days prior to July 25th, 2008 that neither you nor the jury knew. The torment I endured by Dustin Stanley can only be understood by the victims before me."

It Truth brings Justice why did you ignore it? And if Justice was served why must I die in a 10 by 6 cell?"
